This particular individual should continually communicate with residents about the activities which they enjoy and about arranging for activities to be added if wanted by the residents. Yearly, monthly and weekly activity calendars must be maintained and kept up to date.

For a nursing home activity director, the residents are the most vital thing she or he should keep in mind. As often as possible, physical activity must be encouraged and included into nursing home programs. All residents must have opportunities to be active and social within the home, so programs should not be fully based on physical or mental limitations. Outings and activities may be off or on-site, so other staff members and volunteers might be required to ensure the residents' safety. Proper transportation must be arranged also.

There are numerous skills and traits that an activity director should possess. Among the most important traits is compassion. There are times that working with individuals who have varied abilities and needs could be very challenging. As many people age, they tend to withdraw from social settings and lessen the amount of physical activity that they do regularly. Patience and the ability to gently encourage others are good assets in an activity director. The activity director must be understanding while simultaneously be able to calmly deal with any type of situation which might happen. This individual must be very organized but flexible at the same time, since it is impossible to know how individuals with different conditions will react in various or potentially new situations and surroundings. Someone who is both enthusiastic and energetic can inspire residents to wish to participate in the nursing home's activities and to have fun. Having fun could make one's work more fulfilling and satisfying and also increases job satisfaction.

The activity director assesses every resident during activities and keeps paperwork on how residents deal with various activities and outings. The activity director of the nursing home also communicates with the people who are brought in to deliver specific programs and usually observes and accompanies a lot of of the programs too. These activity facilitators will also have input as to their observations and opinions of each resident. These assessments and notes are normally reviewed by the family members, doctors and therapists of the patient to make sure that the senior is content and able to safely participate in the activities that they select.
