A skilled nursing facility is more frequently known as a nursing home. This is because of the fact that nurses carry the majority of the workload in these facilities. All of the nurses in a nursing home facility will have different degrees of qualifications and various specialties. Nurses will directly communicate with the physicians of the patient and other members of the healthcare group in order to guarantee correct patient care. Nursing facilities provide around the clock care to those patients whose requirements are not severe enough to need hospitalization, but are severe enough that they need constant monitoring. If required, the doctor of the patient may make a visit to the nursing facility.

Due to the large number of elderly individuals in skilled nursing homes, these facilities are normally called old folks homes. Nevertheless, in more recent years, new services such as rehabilitation have been included to many facilities. Often, somebody who has recently gone through an operation, like a knee or hip replacement, will stay in a skilled nursing facility for several weeks or months, depending on the needs of their rehabilitation. Major surgeries, such as joint replacements, will be too difficult for most individuals to care for at home, specially if they live alone. A skilled nursing facility provides physical therapy and 24 hour care in a location that is safe and is designed to house individuals with disabilities.
