Assisted living facilities are designed to be either semi-private or private. Depending upon the cost that an individual can afford and the facility, they can have a roommate or they can be housed in a private apartment or room. Lots of facilities are similar in function to university or college residences in that entertainment or dining areas are common areas in the building and they have both semi-private or private rooms. Other facilities are set up similar to condominiums or apartments. In either case, they are generally set up with seniors in mind with security, emergency call buttons and intercoms, and proper handrails to keep residents safe. In most facilities, people could take care of their day to day hygienic needs as well as feed and dress themselves. Services such as laundry, entertainment, cleaning, cooking, transportation and social outing are normally offered as well as offering a safe environment where care could be available in the case of an accident, a fall or a medical emergency. Lots of seniors who live by themselves can not contact someone in the event of an emergency.

In assisted living facilities, residents may or may not require regular nurse visits for administering medications or other medical needs but they are normally free to leave the facility whenever they want. Friends and family members are encouraged to visit regularly, and other fun amenities like for example gardens, beauty salons, walking paths and ponds are often available on the premises.
